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### Professional Learning Day Plan – February 13, 2026

The following is a brief description of our planned professional learning work for February 13. This work is organized around our district's four collective goals:

- All students shall read, write, and communicate at grade level in both languages of instruction.
- All students shall be at grade level in numeracy.
- All students and staff will feel safe, cared for, and engaged in learning.
- All students shall graduate from high school.

School staff will monitor the impact of their work from September 19, and on subsequent professional learning days, in achieving these goals.

#### Literacy

- K-12 teachers will learn about effective instructional practices for teaching writing.
- Grades 1 to 5 FI teachers will continue to expand their knowledge of best instructional practices to support students learning a second language.
- Grades 6 to 12 FI teachers will build capacity to teach foundational grammatical concepts—such as verbs and parts of the sentence—to learners who struggle with grammar or who have had limited exposure.

#### Numeracy

- Teaching teams will review data from the numeracy intervention to determine next steps.

#### Safe, Cared For, and Engaged

- Teachers will learn about engaging, effective activities that they can do with their classes.
- Educational assistants will participate in a session to better understand functions of behaviours, this will directly impact students' feelings of safety, being cared for, and engagement.

#### Graduation

- K-12 teachers will review attendance data to identify and intervene with students who are chronically absent.
