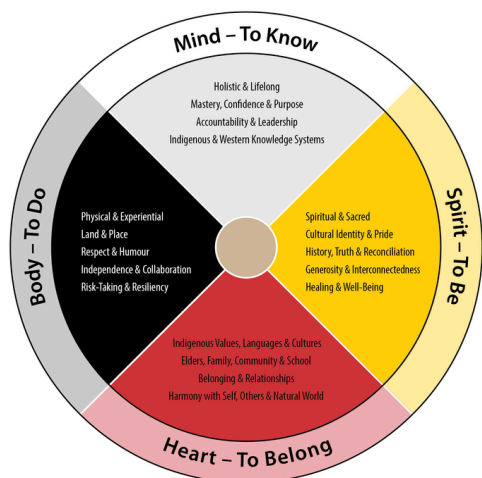

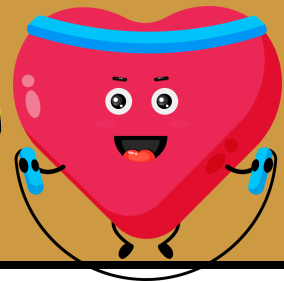


Jump Rope for Heart
